- Lot 1. The National Museum of Ireland have 7 specimens of this type.
- Lot 39. Estimate should read €500-€700
- Lot 41. Comprises 12 pages (including address panel) from a 15 page letter (including address panel). The three missing pages include O'Connell's signing off but his signature is present on the address panel.
- Lot 123. Should read: **1900 Association of Municipal Corporations badge.** Gilt enamel badge A.M.C. DUBLIN 1900 with Dublin City three castles motif at centre, with surround of shamrock surmounted by a harp, made by Hopkins, Dublin, in original box of issue. Rare
- Lot 139. Should read: **1901-1910 Distinguished Conduct Medal renamed to an NCO in The Cape Mounted Rifles (South Africa).** Edward VII issue, renamed to SERGT MAJOR C. SUNDBERG C.M.R., who was not entitled to it. Other Notes: Sundberg's record states "he was a habitual drunkard!"
- Lot 149 Translation of the note: "Very Happy to have found French Sympathetic people at the Hotel Dieu November 1, 1899"
- Lot 161. *Provenance*: Tom Clarke; His widow, Kathleen Clarke; By descent; Clarke Family sale, Adam's, 12 April 2006, lot 317; Private collection.
- Lot 193. This is the second edition (1917).
- Lot 228 and 229 the images are transposed in the printed catalogue
- Lot 282. Should read: Complete badge and furniture on a 6 panel helmet (probably English). Standard issue for the DMP was 4 panel. Scarce.
